<p>Design and make a game involving facts about World War 2 (<i>board game, card game, memory game, observation game</i>).</p>	<p>Create a fact-file about the life of a child during World War 2. This should contain facts about everyday life including: evacuation, rationing and the Blitz.</p>	<p>Design a recruitment poster to encourage people to fight for their country during the War.</p>
<p>Make your own artefact from World War 2 – this could be a rationing book, an evacuation case, a gas mask, soldier's helmet or a medal.</p>	<p>Write a fictional diary as a child during World War 2.</p>	<p>An idea of your own...</p>
