FINISH – 3.15pm

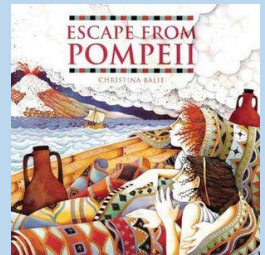

Autumn 1 –Escape from Pompeii



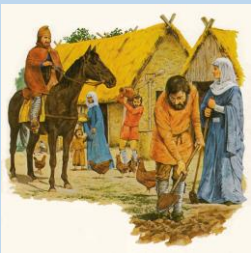
Autumn 2 – Here come the Romans



Spring 1 – Through the Wardrobe



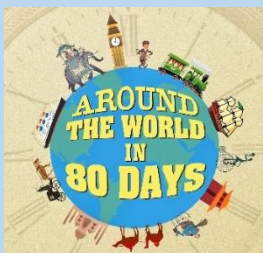
Spring 2 – Anglo - Saxons

False nails or nails painted are not allowed

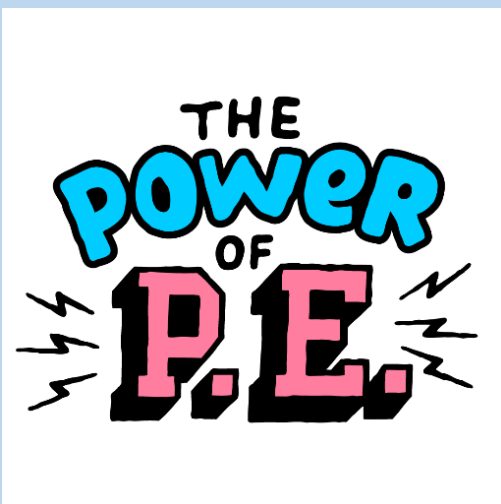
False eyelashes or make-up is not allowed

The MTC's purpose is to ensure the times tables knowledge is at the expected level. In the 2022/2023 academic year, the multiplication tables check (MTC) is statutory for primary schools.
