Topic Theme: Stone Age - Iron

Welcome to Y3

I hope you have all had a lovely half term and are ready to continue our learning in Y3!

In Literacy we will be writing a diary entry based on a short Pixar film and writing an ending chapter for this half term's novel study: *The boy with the bronze axe*. We also be continuing to develop our handwriting, spelling and knowledge of grammar during our literacy sessions.

In History we will be continuing our learning about the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will find out about the chronology of this periods of time and learn about the changes in tools, houses and society during these times.

In DT we will be designing and making an electric poster that could be used in a museum, this will be themed around our history topic.

In Numeracy we will be focusing on addition and subtraction and then moving on to multiplication and division skills.

In Science we will be learning about rocks and soils. We will learn about what soil is made up from and the layers of soil.

In Music we will be creating compositions in response to an animation.

In French we will be learning about the calendar and celebrations.
