In Literacy we will be writing a setting description of a polluted beach and creating our own 'save water' posters using information we find out on our class trip to Yorkshire Water. We will continue to develop our handwriting, spelling and knowledge of grammar.

In Numeracy we will be focusing on multiplication and division and how these link together using the inverse and fact families.

In Geography we will be learning about the how much water is on Earth and where it all is, we will cover the water cycle, rivers (and erosion) and water pollution.

In Science we will be learning about the human body. This will include bones, skeletons, muscles and teeth.

In Art we will be creating a piece of work on seascapes, inspired by Hokusai - The Great Wave.

In Music we will be learning about pentatonic melodies and composition with a Chinese New Year focus.

We will have a trip to Yorkshire Water for a Water workshop and a tour of the water treatment centre.

In French we are learning all about Animals.
