

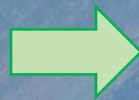
Holly Class Newsletter - Summer 1

I hope you have all had a fantastic break for Easter and are ready for Summer 1 in Holly class.

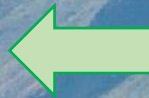
In Literacy we will be writing a setting description of Mr McGregor's garden, using the Peter Rabbit story by Beatrix Potter and the film to inspire us. We will also be writing a fact file all about rabbits. We will continue to develop our handwriting, spelling and knowledge of grammar.



In Numeracy we will be learning about weight & mass, volume & capacity and continuing our learning on Fractions.



In Geography we will be learning about The Lake District, using maps to compare the land use in Windermere compared to the land use in Bolton upon Dearne.



In Science we will be thinking about forces and magnets. We will experiment to see what objects are magnetic and how magnets attract or repel each other.



In DT we will be designing and making a vegetable tart using seasonal vegetables. We will learn how to chop and peel vegetables safely.



In Music we will be learning about the music style of 'Jazz'.
