In Literacy we will be writing a new paragraph for our novel study 'Asha & the spirit bird'. We will also be writing a rhyming poem inspired by India. We will continue to develop our handwriting, spelling and knowledge of grammar.

In Numeracy we will be learning about money, time, shape and statistics.

In Geography we will be learning about the Indian village of Chembakolli using maps to compare the land use in Chembakolli compared to the land use where we live.

In Science we will be thinking about plants. We will look at some of the parts of a plant and what plants need to grow and survive.

In Music we will be learning about traditional Indian music.
